

Jamestown Babe Ruth Minors Baseball Rules

- Pitching Limitations:
For "House" league, the pitchers are limited to no more than two innings per game.
- Teams must bat their entire roster.
- Players may enter and return to any position on the field throughout the course of the game.
- Regulation games are six innings and limited to 1 hour and 45 minutes.
There is a 15 run rule after four innings and a 10 run rule after 5 innings.
- A minimum of 8 players must be present to contest a game.
- Runners on third base may not steal home, score on a passed ball, or score due to an overthrow.
- Runners may not lead off bases until a pitched ball has crossed home plate. Teams will get 1 warning then an automatic out will be issued.
- There is no infield fly rule.
- Runners must slide on all bases when played upon. It will be up to the umpire's discretion to call the runner out. Unless going back to base.
- No head first slides, unless a runner is retreating back to a base. If a runner slides head first when advancing to a base, the runner will be called out.
- If the batter squares up to bunt as the pitcher begins his delivery, and the pitcher stops before he releases the pitch, this will constitute a dead ball and the pitcher will be charged a ball.

- The umpires will not tolerate any arguing on the field by the coaches or players and will be ejected from the game without any warning.
- Last team named on the schedule is the home team, has the third base dug out and is responsible for putting away the bases if your game is the last game of the evening.
